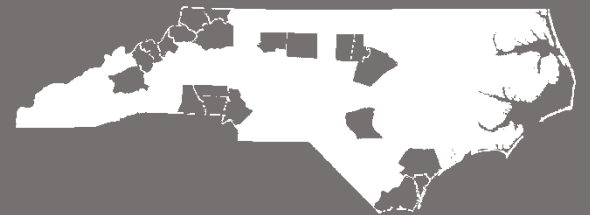

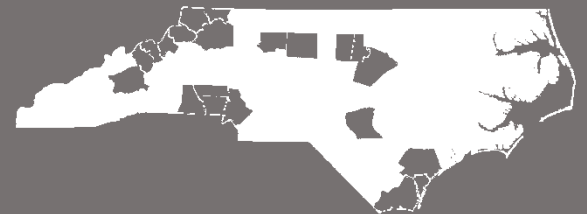


Group Agreements

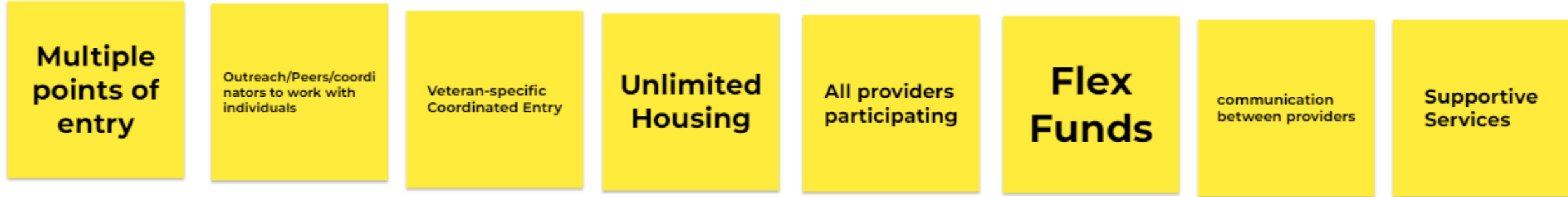

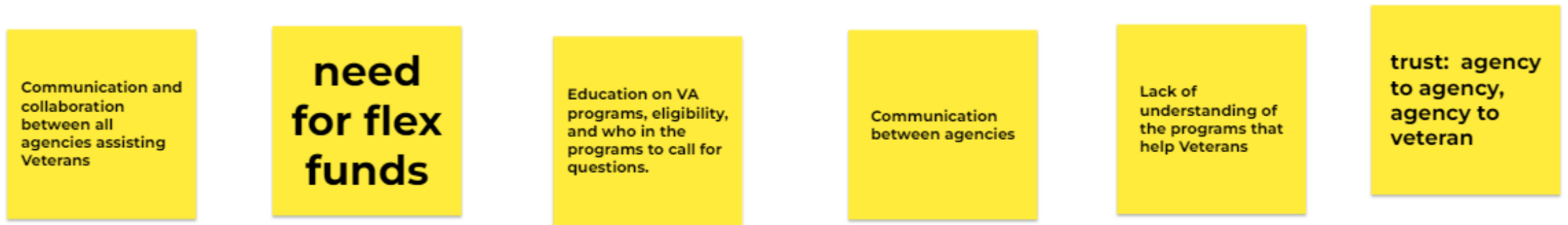
The process a Veteran will go through when facing homelessness

Each partner providing services to Veterans must agree to a standard and specific set of roles & expectations in order to be effective.



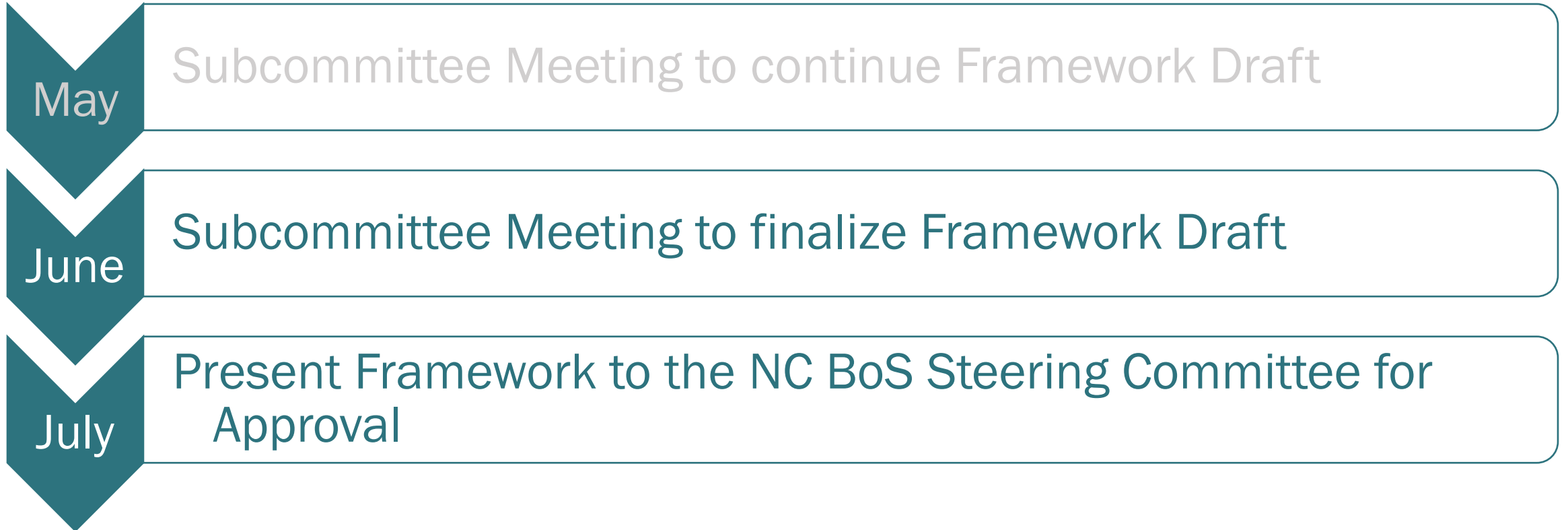
