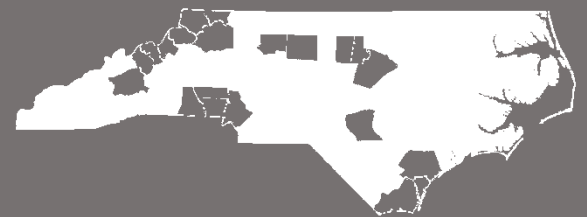


Racial Equity Subcommittee Meeting

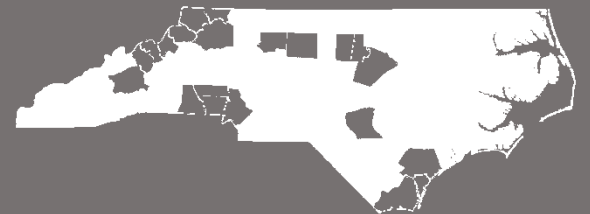


Taking Action

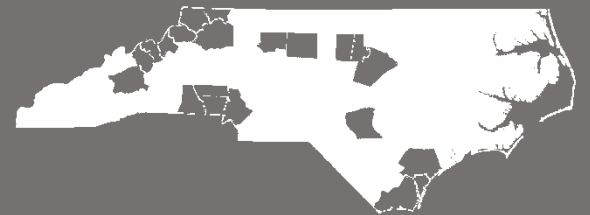

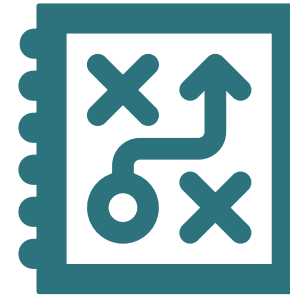
