FY2010 BoS CoC Score

National Scoring Info:

High Score: 91.25 Low Score: 38.5 Median Score: 75.42 Funding Line: 65

The chart below indicates the maximum amount of points available for each scoring category and the actual score the BoS CoC received.

<i>Homeless Needs and Data Collection</i>	26	19.75
<i>CoC Strategic Planning</i>	22	19.5
<i>CoC Performance</i>	32	26.25
<i>Emphasis on Housing Activities</i>	6	6
Total CoC Score	100	84.25

- Federal FY2011 Budget included a \$40 Million increase for McKinney
- HUD announced this increase was not enough to implement HEARTH
- \$ for new projects (and pro rata) will probably be lower than FY2010
- Pre-application will be released after the Pro Rata amounts are published

- All organizations that intend to apply for new AND renewal projects in the 2011 CoC competition should fill out this form.
 - Posted at www.ncceh.org/BoSgrantees/
 - Both Word document and online form
 - Form will allow NCCEH staff and Regional Committees to keep track of who is interested in applying and provide information to potential applicant as necessary.
- Regional Leads can distribute the form to any organization who is interested in applying for CoC funds.
 - NCCEH will share submitted forms with Regional Leads.
- There is no due date for the form. Organizations that know they are interested in applying this year should go ahead and submit the form.
- This form does NOT replace the Pre-Application.

 - Questions for grantees: eligibility requirements, project components, referral process, etc.
